Biography: Mr. Lester Jones is an experienced physiotherapist and educator. He has a Master of Science in Medicine (Pain Management), from the University of Sydney and is currently enrolled in a PhD with the Judith Lumley Centre at La Trobe University. Lester's scholarly activities have been devoted to the translation of research into clinical practice and his current research involves integrating current pain science into clinical management of pain in different contexts. He co-developed the Pain and Movement Reasoning Model and has recently published a chapter titled 'Pain, stress and recovery' in *Psychologically-informed Physiotherapy*. He is an active member of national and international professional groups and was the inaugural chair of the Australian Physiotherapy Association's National Pain Group. He currently works in private practice in Melbourne, provides mentorship to physiotherapists in pain clinic settings, oversees the pain science topics on La Trobe University's Master programs for Musculoskeletal and Sports physiotherapy.

## **Contents of the Course**

The Pain and Movement Reasoning Model is a tool that is used to assist clinicians with their clinical assessment and decision-making for patients with pain. The Model integrates neural, immune and endocrine mechanisms that influence pain and promotes a bio-psycho-social approach to patient management. It was initially created to assist physiotherapists working in musculoskeletal clinics but has also been adapted for post-surgery, pelvic pain in women, breastfeeding pain and pain in survivors of torture and trauma. The Model has been presented at national and international conferences including GP15 (RACGP) and IASP World Congress. This session will introduce you to the Model and illustrate how it can be applied using clinical examples.
