Class Times

Home Study Program

5. "Lymphedema Management" co-authored by Steve Norton. 45 hours of home study are expected of the student. The Home Study Program will provide an opportunity for the student to develop an extensive knowledge of the theoretical components of lymphedema therapy.

Home study course work is required to be completed PRIOR to the live course and represents approximately 45 hours of preparation.

Prior to joining Mercy, Maureen began her lymphedema training while at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania and is also a LANA certified lymphedema therapist. Maureen has presented at the NLN Conference and is currently the lead investigator for an IRB approved research database collecting bio-impedance results. She regularly participates in educational and advocacy efforts to support the understanding of lymphedema, and assists local patient support groups with lymphedema risk-reduction practices.
