Dr. Wai has also extensive subspecialty training in cardiovascular imaging, breast imaging, musculoskeletal imaging, oncological imaging and interventional radiology. Dr. Wai has worked as a consultant radiologist in Union Hospital and a number of local imaging centres. While active in all aspects of cardiovascular and musculoskeletal radiology, he is also passionate about teaching radiology knowledge to fellow clinicians and has delivered more than 80 invited lectures in latest advances in radiology. He also performed multiple live demonstrations on percutaneous image-guided interventions in musculoskeletal, sports and pain medicine.

Wrist

- De Quervains tenosynovitis, tendonitis, carpal tunnel syndrome/CTS DRUJ effusion, carpal instability, synovitis.

Finger & Thumb

- Trigger finger/thumb, tenosynovitis, ligamentous tear, volar plate tear, extensor hoods tear, tendinius tear and rupture.

Neurovascular anatomy and pathology.

Ultrasound guided intervention.
