<p><b>Ms Debbie LOOK</b></p> <p>Debbie is a registered musculoskeletal physiotherapist and sports physiotherapist in Australia. She graduated as a physiotherapist from Hong Kong Polytechnic University (HKPU) and attained her first master degree in manipulative physiotherapy at Curtin University and the second master degree in sports physiotherapy at University of Queensland.
