Mr. Albert Leung is a well-experienced registered physiotherapist in Hong Kong. Being a senior physiotherapist in OPD of Tuen Mun Hospital, he supervised Community Geriatric Assessment Team and Community Physiotherapy Service. Moreover, he was a clinical educator, teaching physiotherapy students for almost 20 years in HK & Mainland China. From the year of 2000, he has worked in a lot of outstanding posts such as an Allied Health Training Officer on secondment to Hospital Authority Head Office, ex-co member of the examination committee of the Hong Kong Physiotherapy Board & the examiner of the Physiotherapy Board Practical Examination for Registration in HK.

Ms. Linda Lai is a well-experienced registered physiotherapist in Hong Kong and worked in Tuen Mun Hospital after graduation from PolyU. In Tuen Mun Hospital, she had been a Case Manager as well as a designated therapist of the Cluster Occupational Medicine Care Service to provide rehabilitation service for staff with work injury and facilitate them to return to work early. Since 2010, she has taken up a post of OSH Manager in HAHO OSH Team to oversee OSH management at corporate level, particularly on Manual Handle Operations (MHO). She organized and conducted “Smart lift policy” training with more than 1,000 trainers being equipped in HA, and also developed a series of MHO training e-courses including skill training on use of various patient material handling aids for frontline healthcare workers .
