ANNUAL REPORT OF PRESIDENT 2018-2019

Prof. Marco Y.C. PANG

This annual report provides a summary of the HKPA events and activities that took place between July 2018 and June 2019.

Executive Summary

This past year was an exciting and fruitful one. We had officially established the vision, mission and motto of our Association. We had held three major events, namely, the World PT Day Carnival, 55th Anniversary Conference and Gala Dinner, and Annual Conference and Gala Dinner 2019. All these three events were hugely successful. In particular, the World PT day had attracted much press coverage. The 55th Anniversary event was well attended, with Dr. Emma Stokes (WCPT President) and a good number of international delegates joining our celebration. The Annual Conference 2019 had even broken the record in terms of the number of participants, with over 180 people attending the conference and more than 230 joining the gala dinner.

We had continued in our efforts to collaborate with various local organizations in promoting health and physiotherapy in the general public. The media coverage had also significantly increased in the past year. On average, HKPA appeared in the media at least once every 2 weeks.

We had also attempted to improve our member engagement by holding the first-ever members' forum on Facebook. It was intended to update our members on the current development and future planning of HKPA affairs. One can expect such forum to become a regular activity as we would like to receive feedback from our members on how HKPA should move forward.

Providing quality continuing education to physiotherapists is one of our core mandates. Through the hard work of our Executive Committee and various Specialty Groups, we were able to have some renowned educators/clinicians/researchers to deliver different seminars, workshops and short courses. HKPA would continue with our effort to offer continuing education opportunities that suit the needs of physiotherapists from different health sectors.

We are pleased to report that our membership subscription had increased substantially by more than 20% compared with the previous membership cycle. This was certainly very encouraging and also a good indicator that our painstaking effort in promoting the Association had paid off.

We also kick started several important projects during the reporting period. First, we had already started to work with a professional company (Accessible IT Development Association Ltd.) to revamp our website. It is expected that the new website would be fully operational before the next membership renewal cycle starts. Second, the project on updating the electronic PT directory had been initiated, and the obtained information would be incorporated into our new website. Third, we were successful in bidding to host the World Confederation for Physical Therapy –Asia Western Pacific (WCPT-AWP) Regional Congress. Held every 4 years, it would be an exciting event in which we can display our expertise in an international platform. We have been working very closely with the Conference Secretariat (International Conference Consultants Ltd) in planning this event, which will be held on June 6-8, 2020 in L'hotel Nina et Convention Centre.

We are committed to enhancing the visibility of HKPA in the international scene. I and several Executive Committee members had served in different positions within the WCPT structure. To foster more regional and international collaborations, we had signed a new MOU with the Macau Physical Therapists' Association, and also held the 2nd Greater Bay Area Physiotherapy Forum during the reporting period.

Due to the increase in membership subscription and successful running of key events and courses, the financial status of HKPA remains very healthy, which is reflected in the Financial Report.

Finally, I would like to express my sincere gratitude to Mr. Patrick L. T. WONG as our Honorary Auditor, and Mr. Bronco BUT as our Honorary Legal Advisor for their contribution to our Association. Thanks to all Executive Committee members of the HKPA and also the Chairpersons and Executive Committee members of the Specialty Groups for their dedication and hard work. Finally, I would like to thank all HKPA members for supporting the Association. Let's join hands in making HKPA and the physiotherapy profession stronger than ever!

ANNUAL REPORT OF HONORARY TREASURER 2018-2019

Hong Kong Physiotherapy Association Limited (HKPA) was incorporated under the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance as a company limited by guarantee and not having a share capital.

The financial statements of HKPA, which comprised the statement of financial position, the statement of comprehensive income, the statement in changes in funds and the statement of cash flows for the year ended 31 March 2019, were audited by Patrick Wong C.P.A. Limited (the "C.P.A.").

The C.P.A opined that the financial statements was given a true and fair view of the financial position, the financial performance and its cash flows of HKPA for the year then ended 31 March 2019, in accordance with Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standard for Private Entities issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants and have been properly prepared in compliance with the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance.

Income

The total income was HK\$3,717,431 in 2018/19 fiscal year, it increased by 104% (i.e. HK\$1,892,410) as compared with 2017/18. Our major income in 2018/19 came from subscription fee (i.e. membership) (52% of total income), activity income (22% of total income), and conference income (21% of total income).

Expenditure

The total expenditure was HK\$2,444,114 in 2018/19 fiscal year, it increased by 36% (i.e. HK\$654,156) as compared with 2017/18. Our major expenditure in 2018/19 came from activity / training courses expenses (43% of total expenditure), postage / stamps / printing / stationary (16% of total expenditure) and conference expenses (12% of total expenditure).

Income Tax

No Hong Kong profits tax and deferred tax has been provided in the financial statements. As more than 50% of gross receipts on revenue account were derived from members, thus HKPA is deemed not to be carrying on a business and therefore is not assessable to profits tax under the Inland Revenue Ordinance.

Cash Flow

Cash and cash equivalents equaled to HK\$5,161,614 as at 31 March 2019, it increased by 36%, i.e. HK\$1,370,188 as compared with 2017/18.

Balance

Balance in funds equaled to HK\$7,584,423 as at 31 March 2019, it increased by 20% i.e. HK\$1,273,317 surplus as compared with 31 March 2018.

Acknowledgement

Finally, we would like to express our thankfulness for the advice and support from the Executive Committee of HKPA and its Specialty Group. Our unity was the key to success in up keeping the prosperous financial position of HKPA and enabled us to advance the physiotherapy profession further.

HKPA Membership




Figure 1: Membership Type

HKPA membership is a prestige identity for registered physiotherapists in Hong Kong. Each newly joined member will receive a package of rewards, including HKPA News Bulletin, Hong Kong Physiotherapy Journal and priority in enrolling on courses and seminars upon annual subscription. With the great bargain in joining Life membership in 2018-2019 year for the celebration of the 55th anniversary of our association, there was a sharp growth in the Life membership (Figure 1). In 2019-2020, the great bargain is sustained and targeted to the fresh graduate. Members are encouraged to update their contacts should there be any changes in order to receive our publications and up-to-date information.

Speciality Groups

HKPA offers courses that help local physiotherapists specialise their skills and professional knowledge. By joining different speciality groups, members can keep updated on the latest knowledge and skills in their selected area of interests. HKPA supports and encourages further development of specialisation, aiming for continuous improvement of our field and promotion of our professionalism. In 2019-2020, Life SG members system was introduced to promote Life members to join SG.

"Go-Green Campaign"

Since 2011, HKPA officially launched the "Go-Green Campaign". We sent out course information and promotion materials via email to members who opted for electronic communication, thereby replacing hard copies. The second phase of the Campaign was launched in 2014, wherein course information will all be sent to members by email and simultaneously published via HKPA homepage / Facebook account. The third phase of the Campaign took place in 2018, the hard-copy version of News Bulletin will be replaced by electronic version. It is advised that members check their email accounts regularly to get hold of the latest news from us.

Members' Welfare




Figure 2: Speciality Groups




Figure 2: Categorized by Workplace

ANNUAL REPORT OF PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT SUBCOMMITTEE 2018-2019

The Professional Development Subcommittee is responsible for overseeing the professional development activities of the Hong Kong Physiotherapy Association (HKPA). Its main functions include holding the annual Specialty Group Meeting with the chairpersons and executive members of specialty groups (SG) to discuss issues related to the planning and organization of professional development activities of HKPA.

A. Annual Specialty Group Meeting and Spring Dinner

On 15 March 2019, the 16th Specialty Group Meeting was held in the HKPA Premises. The Specialty Guidelines for SG were further discussed and revised to formalize the requirements and procedures for forming Working Groups before transitioning to SG. After the meeting, the Spring Dinner was held with the HKPA Executive Committee members, chairpersons and representatives of each SG.

B. Training Courses

1. Learn from the Leaders: Education Scheme for Physiotherapists 2018-2019

The HKPA had collaborated with the Asian Academy for Sports & Fitness Professionals (AASFP) to organize this 6-day course from 15 April 2018 to 21 July 2019. The course covers physiotherapy skills, assessment techniques, case and experience sharing, current treatment trend, usage of latest tools/equipment and communication skills in musculoskeletal areas.

2. Workshops on Orthopaedic Rehabilitation in Greater Bay Area

The HKPA was invited by the Association of Hong Kong Health Care Professionals to deliver three workshops on orthopaedic rehabilitation for the Chinese nurses and therapists of the Greater Bay Area of China. The first two workshops were held on 27-28 April in Guangzhou Orthopedic Hospital and 3-4 August 2019 in Huadu District People's Hospital at Guangzhou. The last one will be held on 7-8 December 2019.

3. Certificate Course in Manual Therapy

The HKPA has collaborated with the Manual Concepts of Australia to organize a 15-day Certificate Course in Manual Therapy on 7-11, 28-30 June, 1-2 July, and 7-11 August 2019.

C. Continuing Professional Development Scheme

The Continuing Professional Development (CPD) programme has been providing our members an assorted and extensive learning opportunity from basic knowledge to specialized skills. In the last year, there were 354 courses accredited in our CPD scheme. The total contact duration of the all accredited CPD activities was 8699 hours (Table 1). Our members could enjoy their learning opportunities, which were provided by different training institutes and academic organizations. In addition, the HKPA SG had organized 26 seminars, certificate courses and workshops in different specialties for our members to uplift their professional knowledge and standards.

The details of accreditation were summarized as follows:

The HKPA Executive Committee members trust that a continuing learning culture is an important element in our professional development. In order to sustain our long term competitiveness, it is essential for us to equip with updated knowledge and advanced skills to embrace the new challenges ahead.

D. Acupuncture Accreditation Scheme

The Acupuncture Accreditation Board of the HKPA was established in 1999 with the intent to uphold the standard of acupuncture practice by physiotherapists and to assure related quality of service delivered to clients. From mid-June 2018 to end of July 2019, there were 131 registered physiotherapists accredited by the Acupuncture Accreditation Board. Among these 131 registered physiotherapists, 101 were members of the HKPA.



Electronic Direct Mail System and Social Network System

We have successfully established an Electronic Direct Mail (eDM) System since 2012 which is more effective and environmental friendly than traditional post office mail. Moreover, we also established a Social Network communication channel through Facebook. The news broadcasted through eDM and Facebook should take place regularly. We have over 90% of members willing to provide email address for EDM purpose. With response to the post in Facebook, the hit rate ranged from a few hundred to about 6 thousand.



Electronic Physiotherapist Directory

Since April 2013, HKPA launched Electronic Physiotherapist Directory (ePTD: http://www.hongkongpa.com.hk/search_physio.html) in order to provide online search of physiotherapy service in Hong Kong for local service users. The ePTD contained more than 350 records of Hong Kong Registered Physiotherapists and it will continuously refreshing and enriching. For Physiotherapist colleagues who would like to share their information for public access, they should complete the data collection form (http://www.hongkongpa.com.hk/Download/20130824_Data_Collection_Form.pdf) and return it to Senior Manager (IT) (physio.brian@gmail.com) for data processing. In order to optimize the searching platform in the directory, a new phase of data collection has been done in the past year. The new search platform will be launched with our new website.

In 2018 and 2019, OSHRSG continued to aim at applying our professional knowledge into our daily practices. One evening seminar was organized regarding the past, present and future work injury management system on 21 February 2019.

With regard to the protection for employees injured at work mentioned in point 210 of policy address (https://www.policyaddress.gov.hk/2018/eng/policy_ch06.html) in 2018, OSHRSG invited two experienced speakers in the field of work rehabilitation.

Dr. Hon KWOK Ka-ki is the Legislative Councillor and he is actively involved in promoting labour rights. Over the years, he strongly requested the Government to set up the Recapacitation and Return-to-Work Fund. In the seminar, he discussed the potential changes in work injury management system based on 2018 policy address.

Ms. Elsa TSANG is the Regional Director of Medical Management Services with American International Group, Inc. (AIG Insurance). She has been a qualified registered nurse since 1991 and now has 20 years practical experience as a Medical Case Manager, specializing in work injury management, catastrophic management, healthcare and nursing care assessment. She shared her expert experience in the work injury management and Voluntary Rehabilitation Programme (VRP) provided by Labour Department.

More than 30 participants had a fruitful evening and they found the information very practical and down to earth. The sharing was especially helpful for those junior therapists because work injury rehabilitation was not really taught and discussed in details during their training.

During the entire year, representatives from OSHRSG had a number of meetings, public hearing and media press with Dr. Hon KWOK Ka-ki regarding the future policy of work rehabilitation and compensation.

In the coming year, OSHRSG will continue to focus on the practical aspect of occuaptional safety and health as well as explore more opportunities to collaborate with other speciality groups and invite foreign speakers to share their expertise and experience on implementation. We plan to launch a practical workshop about various new equipment of manual handling and patient transfer in the 4th quarter of 2019. We look forward to seeing you again!



Dynamic Neuromuscular Stabilization by Dr. Marcela SAFAROVA and Ms. Karolina PTAKOVA

Dynamic Neuromuscular Stabilization (DNS) according to Professor Kolar, is a functional diagnostic treatment approach based on the principles of developmental kinesiology. The DNS concept compares a patient's posture and their movement patterns to the developmental models of healthy infants. This comparison then identifies the discrepancies that need to be treated with therapy. DNS therapy approaches are based on the principles of exercises in developmental positions.





We, co-jointed with PSG, invited renowned instructors Dr. Marcela SAFAROVA and Ms. Karolina PTAKOVA from the Prague School to teach this therapy by delivering the 3-day Basic Course A and the 4-day Paediatric Course I. Over 90% of the participants gave feedback that they were satisfied with the course.



As the use of big data technique such as machine learning and artificial intelligence is a popular trend, our committee member Mr. Indy HO has shared the research methods and results of "Data analytics and machine learning for Oxfam Trailwalkers: Who is more likely to complete the event after received physiotherapy treatment?" in poster presentation session of the HKPA Conference 2019. By training the computer to learn dataset including features and final results from over 1000 trail walkers, the algorithms can base on relevant training and team profiles to predict the probability of completion of event for the coming future.


