Mr. Tsang is the Department Manager of the Physiotherapy Department of MacLehose Medical Rehabilitation Centre and the part-time Professor of Practice of the Department of Rehabilitation Sciences of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University. He is the Vice President of the Hong Kong Physiotherapy Association and the immediate past President and founding fellow of the Hong Kong College of Physiotherapy. He had served in the Education Committee of the Physiotherapists Board and now he is a member of the Registration Committee of the Physiotherapists Board.



DR. IVAN SU HEAD OF PROFESSIONAL AND PROGRAMME DEVELOPMENT, SAHK

Ivan Su is a physiotherapist by profession and currently works as Head of Professional and Programme Development at SAHK and Director of the SAHK Institute of Rehabilitation Practice. He joined SAHK in 1987, specialised in servicing adults with childhood-onset disabilities and community-dwelling individuals living with acquired chronic conditions.
