Biography of Dr. Kenny Chui

As a dementia care specialist, Dr. Kenny Chui is dedicated over 20 years to the needs of people with dementia and their families. Besides the comprehensive experiences on direct dementia service, his expertise extends to academic research, consultative training, public education, project development and management and advocacy. Dr Chui recently developed an initiative "DemenTitude® - the 16 principles of proper caring attitude in dementia", that serves as a prospect for dementia education and promoting proper caring attitude for people with dementia.

Dr. Chui is a distinguished educator who provided 1,150 hours of training from 2016 to 2019. He designs and provides trainings to local and overseas organization such as the HKSAR Food and Health Bureau, Social Welfare Department, Hong Kong Immigration Department, The Hospital Authority, The Hong Kong Council of Social Service, CLP Power Hong Kong Limited, MTR, Bank of China, Consulates of the Philippines and Indonesia. He has also been invited to give guest lectures at tertiary institutions and has presented at international dementia conferences for promoting dementia inclusive languages and the voice of people with dementia.

Dr. Chui is the co-director of the Advanced Diploma Programme in Dementia Care at the Faculty of Medicine, The Chinese University of Hong Kong. He also works with JCCPA to uplift Hong Kong's dementia service. From 2016 to 2019, he collaborated with the Dementia Services Development Centre (DSDC) of the University of Stirling, UK, to develop and launch a three-year Best Practice in Dementia Care Programme, which aims to enhance staff capacity for dementia care service in Chinese communities. Dr. Chui also leads his team to launch the "Jockey Club Post-diagnostic Support in Dementia Care Programme", which based on the 5 Pillars Model of Alzheimer Scotland to help people with dementia to establish individualized dementia care plans and equip the care partners with practical skills. Dr. Chui guides his team to launch the "Jockey Club Younger Onset Dementia Support Project", which is the first pilot project in Hong Kong to deliver quality dementia service for people with younger onset dementia. Currently, Dr Chui leads his team to launch the "Jockey Club "Brain Health" Dementia Screening and Community Support Project, which promote dementia diagnosis and support at primary healthcare setting and facilitate medical-social collaboration on dementia care.
